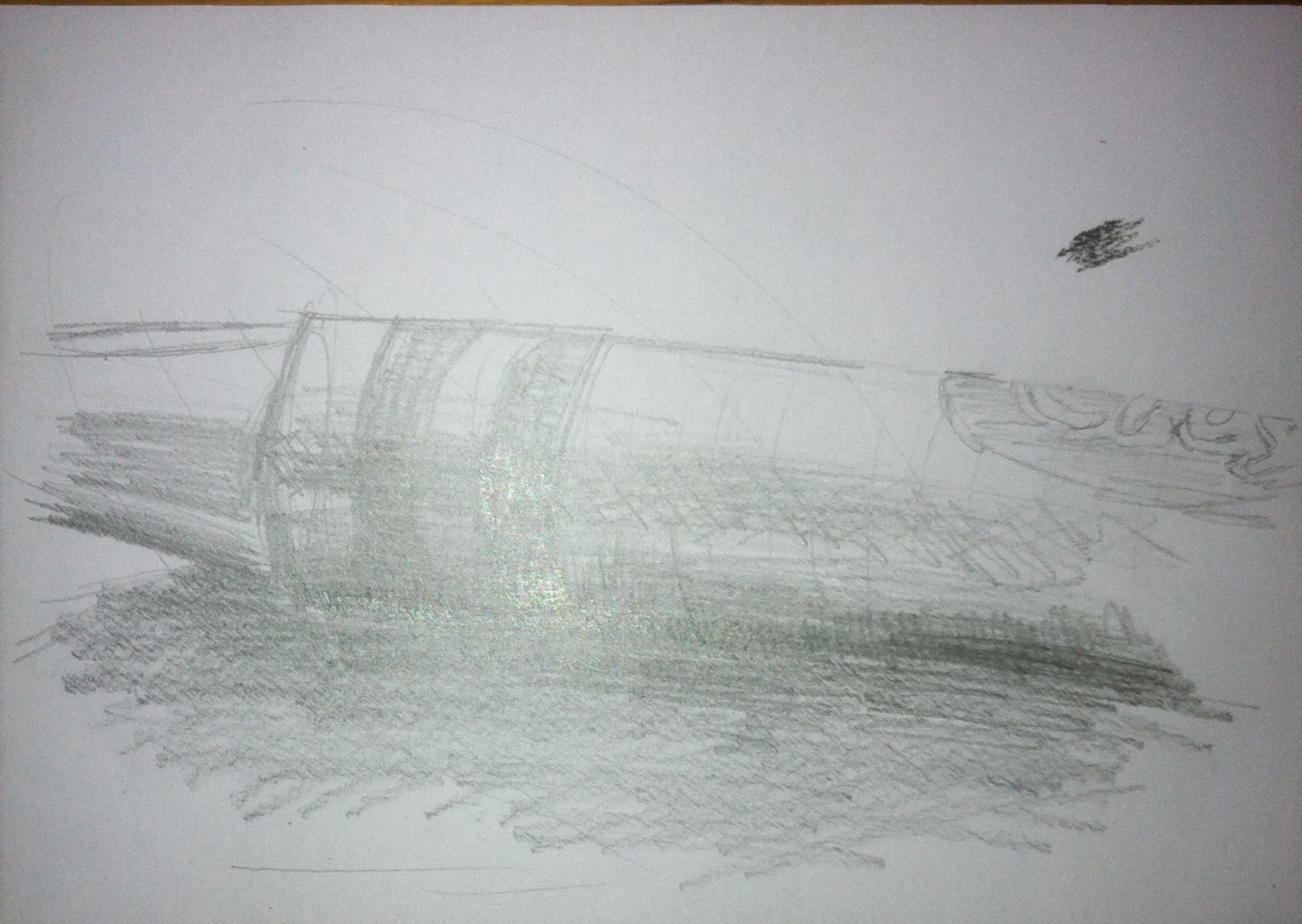

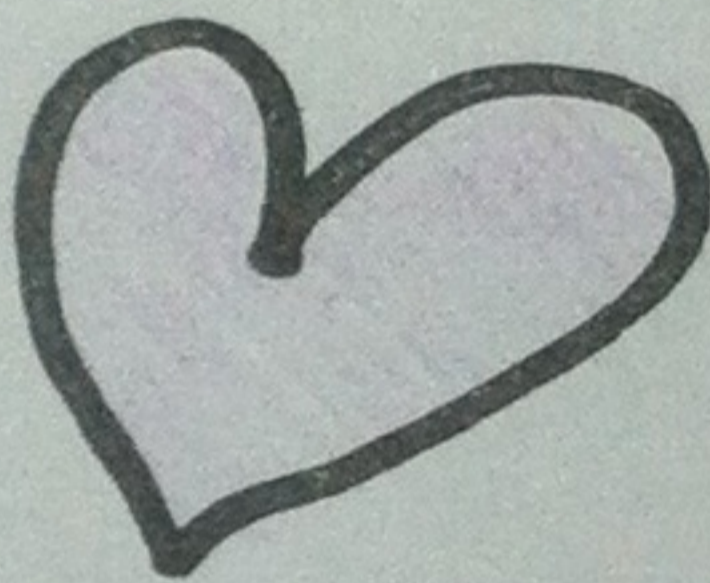
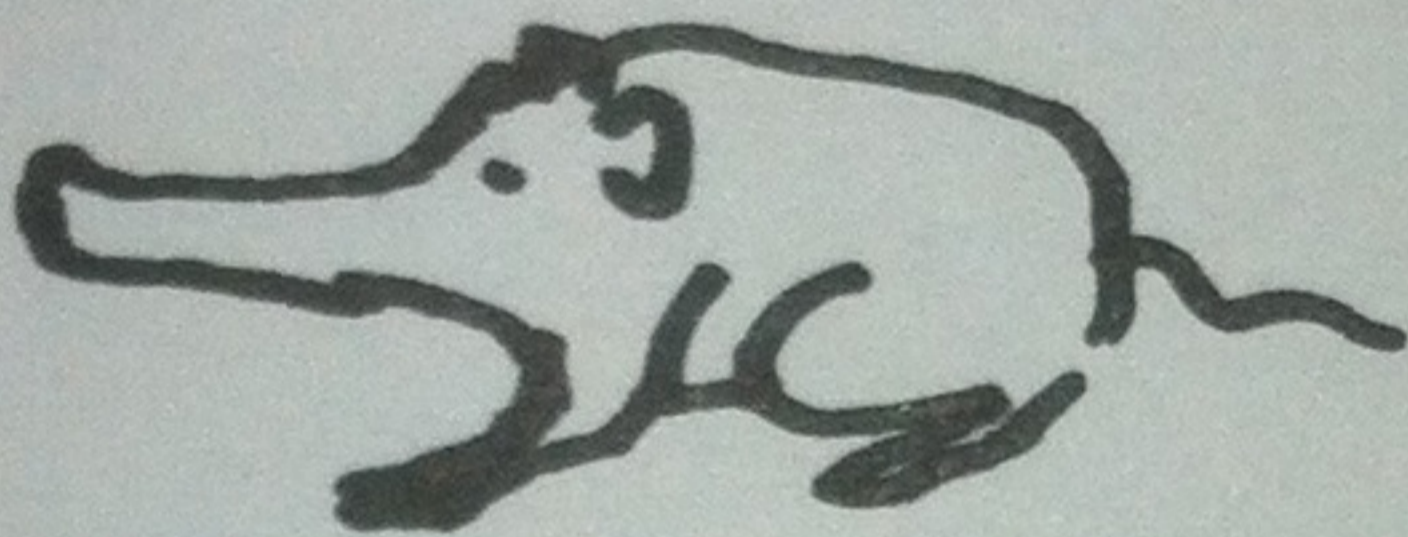
Everyone who respects this approach is welcome at Revolt, regardless of gender, sexual orientation, age, ethnicity, religious views etc etc.

DIY
sticker tape

Materials Paint (acrylic or emulsion)  A + paintbrush (biggish)
Paper, a sharp knife!, fabric

① Get a stencil drawn on some paper - make sure it's big enough to cut out! Draw it or do it on a PC (or check Stencilpunk.org for boards already made for you)

△ Cheap rags from the market, the leftover denim from last summer's cut offs, your pants etc.

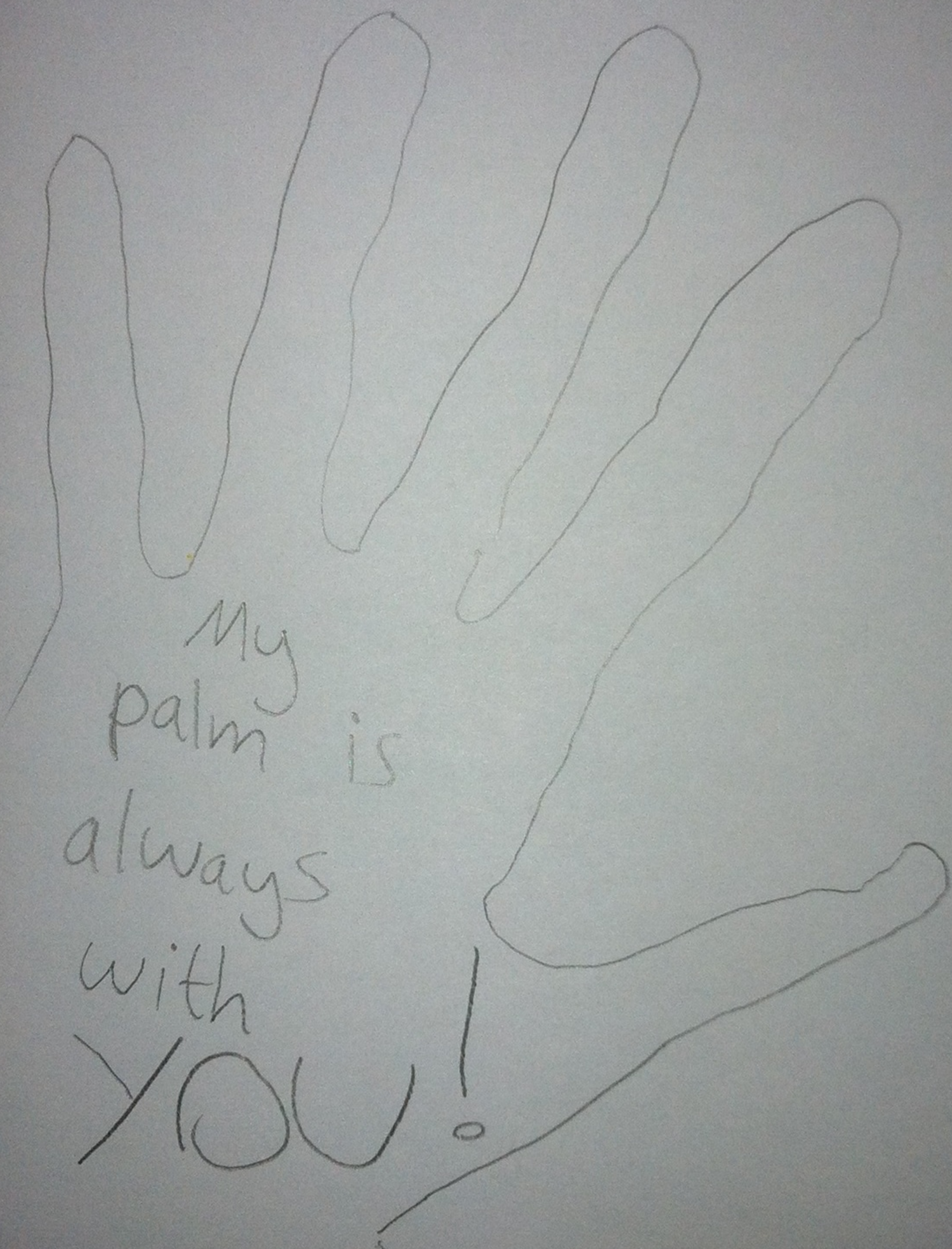
③ Paint! Try using as little as possible or it will leak under the paper ☹️. ~~Brush~~ the stipple over all the stencil until

② Cut out the stencil with your knife - take your time + go ~~slow~~ sloooooow. Repair any mistakes with tape then tape it to your fabric.

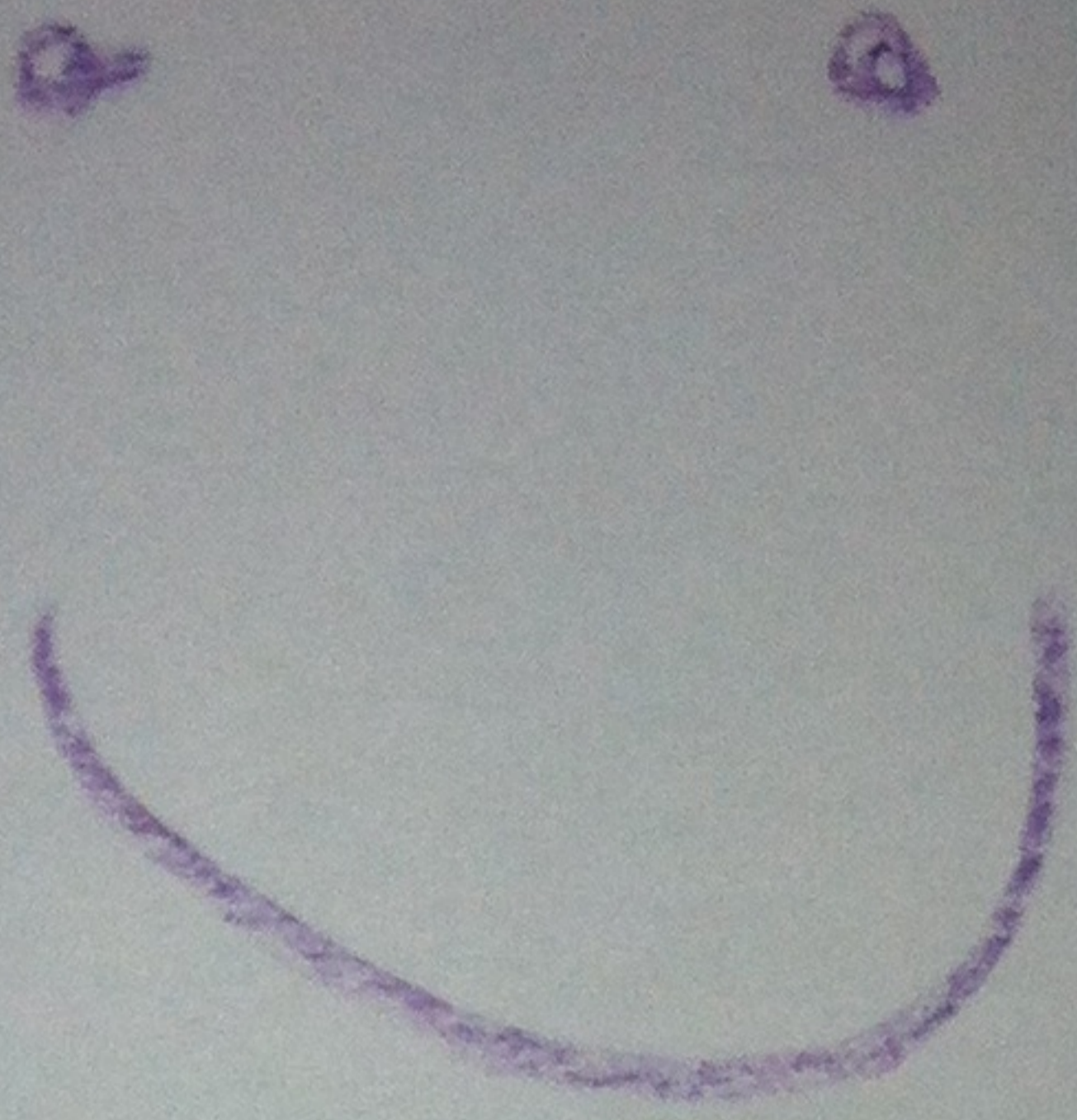
△ you're happy with the colour + take it slow again. Be lazy!

To think that the world should think that I could care about her gender more than the fucking dogshit me.

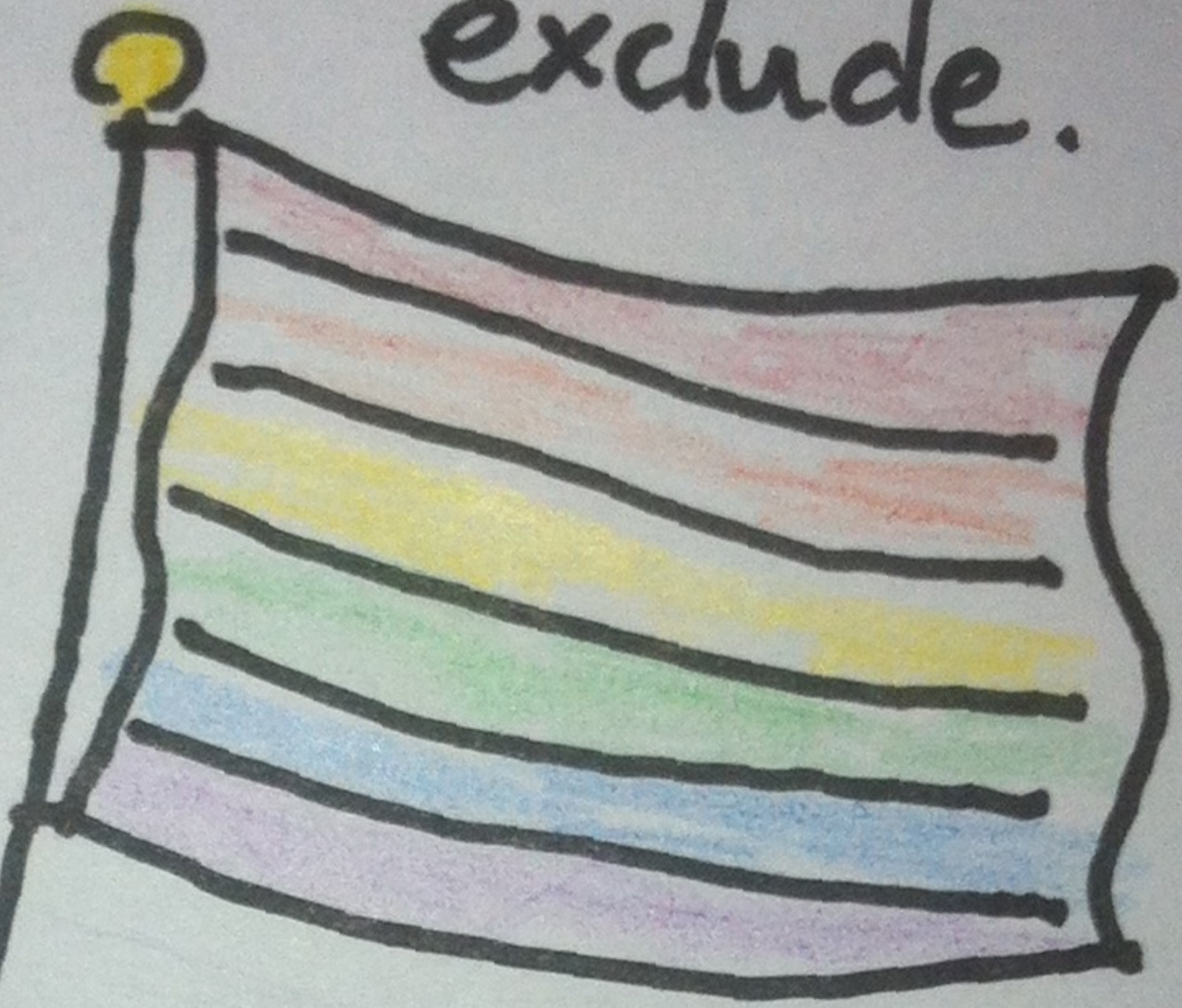
I don't claim to speak for anyone but myself; but I love her, I have always loved her, and I love everybody.

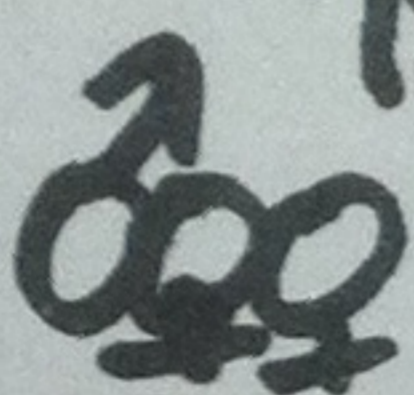

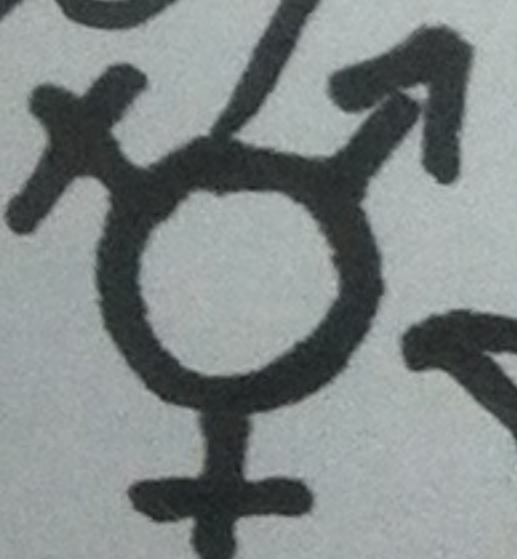
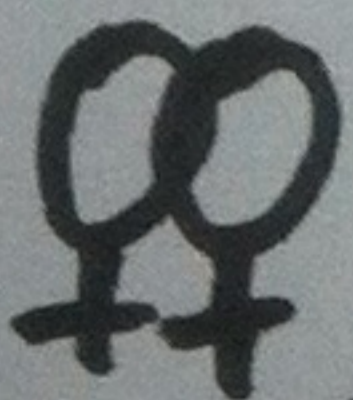
